Still, a dam to collect water for the animals, or a well to provide clean, safe drinking water to the people can be built for a few thousand \$ each!

FOR MY 50TH BIRTHDAY, MY AIM IS TO COLLECT AT LEAST 50 TIMES 50 = 2500\$ FOR DRILLING A WELL IN NYABUSHOZI COUNTY... AND HOPEFULLY (MUCH) MORE!
